SUSPECT ARRESTED FOR NUMEROUS TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS

Around 3 a.m., February 17, 2010, officers on patrol in the area of Cedar Street observed a suspicious vehicle and learned the registration plate did not match the vehicle. Officers attempted to stop the car for further investigation.

The suspect ignored blue lights and sirens and continued to drive until he reached the intersection of Oak Street and Hamilton drive, where he jumped out of the moving vehicle. The suspect fled on foot into Craven Terrace and was taken into custody a few minutes later. Other passengers inside the vehicle stopped the car. No one was injured as a result of the incident.

Shontell Trenard REED, D.O.B. 9/4/1978 of 807 Eubanks St., was charged with Driving While Impaired, Possession of Marijuana, Failure to Stop for Blue Lights and Siren, Fictitious Registration plate, Careless and Reckless Driving, Resist Obstruct and Delay, No Operator's license and speeding. **REED** was booked into the Craven County Jail under a \$1,000.00 secured bond.
