“Suspect Located in Pamlico County”

On September 23, 2010 Officers of the New Bern Police Department along with members of the NC State Bureau of Investigation, Alcohol Law Enforcement Division and North Carolina Department of Probation and Parole executed search warrants on four separate locations pursuant a series of Armed Robbery investigations. Those search warrants led to the arrest of twelve suspects with 2 suspects remaining at large.

On October 4, 2010 Deputies of the Pamlico County Sheriff’s Office located was arrested **Kahiry JONES B/M D.O.B. 12/1/1990** of 907 Broad Street New Bern without incident. **JONES** was wanted in connection with this investigation and was subsequently charged with Robbery with a Dangerous Weapon and Conspiracy to Commit Armed Robbery. **JONES** booked into the Pamlico County Jail under a \$500,000.00 secured bond with a first appearance of 10/6/2010.

The New Bern Police Department is still searching for **Kyale TAYLOR, B/M D.O.B. 8/7/1991** of U-2 236 Craven Terrace New Bern. **TAYLOR** is wanted for Conspiracy to Commit Armed Robbery and Armed Robbery. **TAYLOR** is considered armed and dangerous. Anyone with information regarding the whereabouts of this suspect is asked to contact the New Bern Police Department Major Case Unit at (252)672-4100.
