MAN SHOT WHILE IN CRAVEN TERRACE

On September 12, 2011 at 9:38 pm, officers responded to Craven Terrace for a report of numerous shots heard being fired near the W and V Buildings of the complex. Upon arrival, officers were told **Brandon Karin HILL, DOB: 6/7/1983, 203 Commons Court, New Bern, NC** had been shot during the reported gunfire. **HILL** was not at the scene when officers arrived.

During the investigation, police learned **HILL** was at CarolinaEast Medical Center for treatment and police spoke to him there. **HILL** reported he had parked his vehicle and was walking to the W Building to visit friends when he was struck by a bullet in the left knee. **HILL** then left Craven Terrace with the friends he intended to visit and went to the hospital for treatment. **HILL** stated he was apparently hit by a stray bullet and was not engaged in an exchange of gunfire.

Witnesses at the scene stated the gunfire came from a silver van possibly occupied by four subjects. There were no other leads or descriptions given.

This case is still under investigation. Further information will be released as it becomes available.
